ACHIEVEMENT OF BHAIRABI CLUB DURING THE YEAR

I. WELFARE OF THE PWDs

Bhairabi club is being implementing various Projects / Programme for the Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) since 1995 with the assistance from Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi under **DEENDAYAL DIVYANGJAN REHABILITATION SCHEME(DDRS)** in Khordha District. During the year the following projects were implemented for Rehabilitation of PWDs. .

A. SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR THE CHILDREN WITH OTHER DISABILITIES (Intellectual Disability)

A Special School is being run at-Kurumpada, po-Hadapada, Dist-Khordha with the assistance from Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi since 1st March 1995. As per revision of the Scheme the School has been separated during the year 2023-24. The school is only for the Intellectual Disability children. The school offers educational facilities from Pre-Primary to Vocational for intellectual challenged children. The school is fully residential with free accommodation, food, cloth etc. The Capacity of the School is 40. Adequate number of qualified staff and care giving staffs are appointed as per scheme and given their utmost services to the Children.



Besides Education the School provides Boarding/Hostel facilities, Vocational training and Rehabilitation services to the Divyangjan children through a broad-based curriculum that includes academic, physical and Creative Arts. Other activities like; Daily living skills, Morning Assembly, Evening Prayer, Kitchen Gardening, Sports and games etc. are also done regularly. The children of this Special School participate in various Districts, states and national level sports & cultural meet conducted in observance of international day for the PWDs. No GIA has been received for the year 2023-24.

B. SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR THE CHILDREN WITH HEARING DISABILITIES WITH OPTION FOR HOME BASED REHABILITATION & COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION.

A Special School is being run at-Kurumpada, po-Hadapada, Dist-Khordha with the assistance from Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi since 1st March 1995. As per revision of the Scheme the School has been separated during the year 2023-24. The school is only for the Hearing Disability children. The school offers educational facilities from Pre-Primary to Class- VIII for Hearing Disability children. The school is fully residential with free accommodation, food, cloth etc. The Capacity of the School is 25. Adequate number of qualified staff and care giving staffs are appointed as per scheme and given their utmost services to the Children.

Besides Education the School provides Boarding/Hostel facilities, Vocational training and Rehabilitation services to the Divyangjan children through a broad-based curriculum that includes academic, physical and Creative Arts. Other activities like; Daily living, Morning Assembly, Evening Prayer, Kitchen Gardening, Sports and games etc. are also done regularly. The children of this Special School participate in various District, states and national level sports & cultural meet conducted in observance of International day for the PWDs.

The school also provides Home Based Rehabilitation and Community Based Rehabilitation to the children remain in the community. No GIA has been received for the year 2022-23 and for 2023-24.

C. REHABILITATION OF LEPROSY CURED PERSONSWITH OPTION FOR HBR & CBR

The home for the Leprosy cured persons funded by Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment under Rehabilitation of Leprosy cured persons was established at Shaktibihar (Kurumpada), Po-Hadapada, Dist-Khordha during the year 1998-99. The intake capacity of the Home is 30.the aim of the home is to provide rehabilitation services to the leprosy cured persons and create awareness on blind belief to bring them mainstream of society. During the year under report 08 female Leprosy Cured persons and 22 male Leprosy Cured persons are resided in the Home. No GIA has been received for the year 2023-24.

D. HALF WAY HOME FOR PSYCHO-SOCIAL REHABILITATION OF TREATED AND CONTROLLED PERSONS WITH MENTAL ILLNESS WITH OPTION FOR HBR& CBR.

There are so many treated and controlled persons with mental illness in the society. They are not properly getting food, clothes and shelter. No one look after them. They are teased by others. They are neglected by their family. So, keeping in mind for the Rehabilitation of treated and controlled persons with Mental illness the organisation opening a Half way Home at Kurumpada, Khordha since March 2022. They are being provided with free boarding and lodging facility. Vocational Training has been imparted for them for their rehabilitation. The organsiationalso taking steps for their Home-Based Rehabilitation and Community Based Rehabilitation. There are no funds received from Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi for the year 2022-23 and 2023-24. The Project is pending with Central Ministry for GIA. The intake capacity of the Home is 25.

F. OTHER ACTIVITIES FOR WELFARE OF THE DIVYANGJAN.

Mental Health Day has been observed in the campus of Bhairabi club in each and every year by the collaboration with (TLSA) District Court of Khordha. Hon'ble Judges from the Court participated in the programme.

II. SOCIAL DEFENSE: -

i. DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION (NAPDDR): -

During the last decade there has been a marked increase in the use of Psycho active or Mood-altering drug in our society among the youth and adolscents. Drug abuse and dependence seem to be the most common of human. The association between drug taking and Juvenile crime among the drug users is also causing alarm. Collective action is not just a concept. It's a process for finding solutions when problems are too complex, too significant and too deeply rooted to be solved by any one group or approach. For Drug Demand Reduction and to build a drug free society Bhairabi club is being running Programme under National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction for de-addiction, sensitization and rehabilitation of the drug addicts in Khordha and Ganjam District of Odisha.

a. JEEVANJYOTI – INTEGRATED REHABILITATION CENTRE FOR ADDICTS AT KHALIKOTE of GANJAM DISTRICT: -



The JeevanJyoti Drug De-addiction-cum-Rehabilitation centre was established at NirmalJhar (Khalikote) in Ganjam district with financial assistance from Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, and New Delhi during the year 1998-99. The objective of the centre promotion IEC activity in the field of drug abuse prevention and HIV/AIDS and detoxification of the drug addicts and bring them mainstream of the society. During the year 180 addicts were admitted in to the center All services including fooding provided to the indoor patients with free of cost.

Community Awareness programme, Home Visit, Follow-up programme also done by the IRCA regularly.

b. DIBYAJYOTI – INTEGRATED REHABILITATION CENTRE FOR ADDICTS, NARANGARH OF KHORDHA DISTRICT: -



The Integrated Rehabilitation centrefor Addicts (IRCA) is being run at TapangRailway Station Road -Narangarh since 1999-2000 with the assistance from Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi. The centreprovidesOPD and Indoor services. Psychotherapy Support programme like Individual Counseling, Group Counseling, and Family Counseling. Physical education, Yoga& Meditation also provided to all Indoor patients



during treatment period. Regular Medical treatment being provided by a MBBS Doctor and free fooding also provided to the patients. All services including medicine and fooding provided to the indoor patients with free of



cost. Community Awareness programme, Home Visit, Follow-up programme also done by the IRCA regularly. During this year 182 nos.



of addicts admitted in to the center and 175 addicts got detoxified and successfully rehabilitated and out of them

105nos.of addicts enjoy drug free life. In addition to above World Aids Day and International day against Drug abuse and illicit trafficking day also observed in the centre. During the year 2019 Govt. of Odisha, SSEPD Deptt.given BEST-IRCA award to this Institution. This organisaion also organized Rally, Awareness meeting on 26th June 2023 to observe the International Day against Drug Abuse and illicit Trafficking. International Yoga Day, No Tabbaco Day also celebrated in the IRCA. The IRCA has been accredited by NABH and the PMU of NISD, Min of SJ & E, New Delhi visited the center regularly. G I A has been received for the year 2023-24(1st instalment) The 2nd instalment is not released.

ii. **INTEGRATED PROGRAMME FOR OLDER PERSON:-**

a. **SENIOR CITIZENS HOME- I, PANICHHATRA :-**

With financial support of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India this organisation established on Senior Citizen's Home (Ashakiran) at Panichhatra in Khordha district during the year 1991-92. The home is catering the service need of 25 older persons. Boarding, Lodging, Cloth, Soap, Oil and Healthcare & Medicine services are provided in free of cost. Outing & Recreation facilities are provided each and every year in free of cost. The International Day of Older Persons has been celebrated with collaboration of Zilla Swasthya Samiti, Khordha on 1st October 2023. The 1st instalment GIA received for the year 2023-24 by the NGO for maintenance of the Home. The 2nd instalment is not released .



b. **SENIOR CITIZENS HOME -II AT KURUMPADA**

With financial support of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India the Multi Service Care Center converted to Senior Citizens Home from 1.4.2018. The Home is running at Kurumpada of Khordha District with 25 Senior Citizens. During the year 17 male and 8 female Senior Citizens enrolled in the home and get all benefiits as per IPOP norms. Boarding, Lodging, Cloth, Soap, Oil and Healthcare & Medicine services are provided in free of cost. Outing & Recreation facilities are provided each and every year



in free of cost. The 1st instalment GIA received for the year 2023-24 by the NGO for maintenance of the Home. The 2nd instalment is not released. The State Coordinator, PMU, Ministry of SJ& E, New Delhi and SVNIRTAR, cuttack, DSSO, Khordha, State Govt. Team amd visited the Home and express their satisfication on running of the programme.

IV. WOMEN & CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMME: -

Despite of various constitutional legislation are being implemented for the safeguard of the women still they are weakened and vulnerable situation. The development of women and children are the major concern of the society. To the challenge and empower & rehabilitation of distress & difficult circumstance women this organization takes sincere initiatives and implemented various projects. During the year the Govt. of Odisha, W & CD Department, Bhubaneswar launched the new program Jagruti instead of Swadhar Greh & Ujjawala. The Govt also kind enough to sanction funds for the Jagruti Scheme in favour of this NGO. The scheme is as follows.

JAGRUTI- A SCHEME FOR WOMEN IN DISTRESS.

The scheme focuses on the welfare and empowerment of women and children, catering to the following target groups.

- Women and children who are vulnerable to or have been rescued from commercial sexual exploitation.
 - Women and girls who are in need of care and protection facing difficult circumstance.
- The following sub-schemes are being proposed under the umbrella scheme covering the unique needs of the target groups.

1- **JAGRUTI-I : Scheme for survivors of commercial sexual exploitation .**

2- **JAGRUTI- II: Scheme for survivors of distress situations.**

A. JAGRUTI-I :-

The Govt. of Odisha, W & C.D Department pleased to sanction funds for the new project Jagruti-I (erstwhile ujjawala) during the year 2023-24 to give shelter and rehabilitation for survivors of commercial sexual exploitation. The project is running at Samantarapur, Khordha. The intake capacity of the inmates of the home is 50. Boarding and lodging, soap and oil, Clothing, Medical Care, Legal aid, counselling services and vocational training are provided to the inmates in the home are free of cost.

B. JAGRUTI-II:

The Govt. of Odisha, W & C.D Department pleased to sanction funds for the new project Jagruti-II (erstwhile Swadhar Greh) during the year 2023-24 to give shelter and rehabilitation to the women in difficult circumstance. The project is running at Ogalpada, Janla, Bhubaneswar. The intake capacity of the inmates of the home is 50. Boarding and lodging, soap and oil, Clothing, Medical Care, Legal aid, counselling services and vocational training are provided to the inmates in the home are free of cost.

C. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SERVICE PROVIDERS.

Now a day's violence against women has increasing very tediously day by the day. To solve the problems of women and girls , Govt. of Odisha, Deptt. Of W& CD established a protection unit in each district and entrusted one leading NGO working in the field of Women and Child Development as service providers. In Khordha district Department of Women and child Development has entrusted Bhairabi Club as a service provider agency.

V. CHILD WELFARE:-

Realizing the need for an effective service delivery to the children in need of care and protection for living with dignity Bhairabi Club has been implemented various child welfare programme.

a. CHILDLINE -1098 SUPPORT ORGANISATION

In collaboration with CHILDLINE INDIA FOUNDATION one CHILDLINE – SUPPORT organization is running at Khordha since 2010-11



Childline is working 24 hours round the clock to provide services to children at risk or vulnerable condition. In addition to that, the childline provides outreach services for children in need of Care &



Protection. It reaches out to the most marginalized children with the aim of providing them rehabilitation and came from unsafe situations. CHILDLINE works with children in the space of Shelter, Medical aid, repatriation, rescue, emotional support and guidance etc. During the year report CHILDLINE provides Shelter, Medical aid, Reparation, Rescue and etc to the children. Outreach services, Open house camp and awareness programmes were organized. The team members play an important role in stopping Child Marriage in the District. The team member Mr. Manilal Sahoo awarded Certificate and a Cash Prize of Rs.3000/- and The Team member Pranati Pattanaik also awarded Certificate and a cash prize of Rs.2000/- from Ruchika Samaj Mangal Sangathan, Bhubaneswar for their achievement in Prohibition of Child Marriage in Khordha District.

The Childline was closed by the funding agency from the 2023-24 (August-23)

c. OPEN SHELTER FOR CHILDREN IN NEED CARE & PROTECTION:-

The Govt of Odisha, Deptt. Of Women & Child Development, Odisha State Child Protection Society was kind enough to sanction the Grant-in-Aid under ICPS for establishment of one Open Shelter for children in need in Urban & Semi-Urban area. The Shelter was established during the year 2011-12 w.e.f. 1st April 2012. At Khordha Town with three contact points at (i) Munda Sahi Bhubaneswar, (ii) Jatni Municipality and (iii) Khordha Municipality. The shelter is being functioning at Khordha. The Shelter has been visited by the Sub-Collector, Khordha, DCPO, Khordha and members of CWC, Khordha regularly.



VI. HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE:-

Health is considered as a fundamental human right. Bhairabi Club from its very year of inception has been actively implementing health & family welfare programmes to fulfill the basic needs of people. This organization has taken initiative providing preventive, promotive and curative health facilities to the people of Khordha District. Organising Blood Donation Camp in different Colleges of Khordha Dist.

a. **ASHA TRAINING**

b. **ORGANIZATION OF IEC & ADVOCACY ACTIVITIES**

With an aim to sensitize the urban slum people in the project area of JATNI AND KHORDHA municipality this organization organized the IEC and Advocacy activities in collaboration with National Health Mission regularly i.e World Breast Feeding week, New Born care week, Intensive IEC and social mobilization campaign, Infant Youth Child Feeding Campaign, observation of girl child day, awareness programme on societal application of atomic energy and motivational camp for immunization and family planning in the slum area. During the month of March we organize Awareness programme in the area to break down the chain of COVID-19 - CORONA virus .

c. **URBANMOBILEHELATH UNIT.**

With Financial assistance from Urban Health Mission an UHMU is being running in Jatni and Khordha Municipality. since 2016-17. The Unit was sanctioned by NHM, Odisha. The Mobile Health Unit comprising one Doctor, one Pharmacist , one ANM with a vehicle organised health camps in urban slum areas of Khordha and Jatni Municipality regularly.

d. **COMMUNITY PROCESS ACTIVITIES ON HEALTH:**

During the year under report in collaboration with District Swasthya Mission, National Health Mission, Khordha, this organization has taken initiative for formation of Mahila Arogya Samiti (MAS) in Khordha Urban areas. The Community Procees Project for Urban Slum areas of Khordha Municipality was sanctioned by the NHM, Odisha during the year 2016-17. The project is continuing to run in the slum areas. Under this project activities like formation of Ward Kalyan Samiti, functioning of MAS, slum sensitization programme followed by street play, orientation of WKS members training of MAS members selection of ASHA, slum resource mapping, Dengu prevention programme etc. has been undertaken by the organization in Urban slums of Khordha and Jatni Municipality. During the year NDDmiking activities, AVDS for urban immunization, AVDS, BCC/ICC activities for IPPI, AVDS for Covid 19 vaccination were oranised by

XI DISASTER MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:-

Odisha has been experiencing natural disaster like flood, drought and cyclone almost every year. While flood and drought house become common features in the state, cyclone is not frequently observed. Natural calamities have not only become a problem for the state of Odisha but have also become a threat to sustainable development as the vulnerability has been increasing due to national disaster. To facing the challenge Bhairabi Club, in collaboration with District Administration and Odisha State Disaster Mitigation Authority was implementing Disaster Risk management Programme in Khordha Block of Khordha District. During this year Bhairabi club distributed free food to the flood affected people of Orabarsingh and Narangarh G.P. of Khordha District and rescue the victims and gave shelter them in Multy cyclone shelter.

XIV. HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT:-

The operation was made by the Netram Hospital in free of cost.



XVII. VAIRABEE ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOL

Due to the poor performance of the General Schools the student of the rural area do not compete with Urban children. So for the educational development of rural children and to provide quality education one English Medium School is being established at Kurumpada . Bhairabi Club Provides all the facilities like building, water, sanitation and play ground to the students. The school provides educational facilities to the rural children from Pre-Nursery to Standard – VIII.

LIBRARY & READING ROOM :-

A good library and reading room is established in the institution since 1977. The Ministry of HRD, Department of culture, New Delhi provides the assistance for strengthening of the Library. The Raja Ram Mohan Ray has been providing the books and furniture for the development of the Library.

SPORTS & CULTURE

Sports and cultural programme is a part of human life. Every and each year the club organized sports competitions and cultural program like Drama has been organized in the villages . Ganesh Puja, Janmastami, Mahostav etc. also Celebrated with due pomp and ceremony.

INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTATION :-

This institution maintains an extensive service library, which is stocked with renewed publications manuals, journals and books in the field of rural development, Social Welfare, Information Technology & Social Defense, Welfare of Persons with Disabilities, Consumer Welfare, Govt.
